The Seghesio family was the first to grow Pinot Grigio in the Russian River Valley, where the climate allows slow maturation of the fruit, while the coastal fog expresses varietal character and retains acidity. The result is an intriguing wine with ripe apple and quince aromas, slight tropical and stone fruit characteristics, and flavors of spiced apple and citrus.
